Some products we plan to make include:

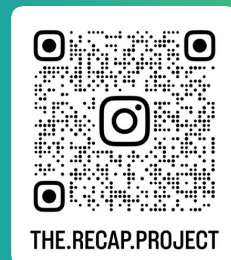

Know:

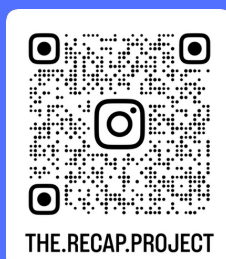
- Only 9% of waste we put in recycling actually gets recycled!
- Our non-profit is dedicated to recycling clean medical plastics into usable products
- Clean needle caps from vaccines, insulin syringes, and phlebotomy can be recycled
- Syringe collars from flu vaccines, Adacel, and PCV20 can be recycled

Do:

- Collect clean safety needle caps, and white/clear collars after immunization (after safely disposing of sharps)
- Collect in any cardboard box and contact your site lead or brandon@therecapproject.org to arrange pickup for recycling
